



EXTREME AGILITY TRIAL

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

1. The handler can use any language of his/her choice for the commands that he/she will use with his/her dog.
2. Rewards such as tug, ball, food, etc. are allowed.
3. Each handler and dog tandem will be given three (3) tries per round in their chosen agility trial (either Hurdle, Palisade, or Long Jump).

TIE BREAKING RULES:

1. Once the maximum height or length of the agility equipment is reached and there are still more than one (1) tandem left, one (1) more round will be performed by the finalists with the agility equipment already set to its maximum height or length.
2. After Item No. 1 and still more than one (1) tandem have made it through, the tandem with the least number of tries will win the tie breaker.
3. However after Item No. 2 and the finalists still has the same number of tries, height (smaller) and weight (bigger) will be used as the determining factor for the winner.

AGILITY TRIALS:

HURDLE:

- There will be an agreed starting height to which will increase gradually per round once all the participating tandems have already taken their turns.
- A dog will be considered to have passed a round when the dog has successfully jumped over the Hurdle without touching it within the three (3) tries. No return jump is necessary.

PALISADE:

- There will be an agreed starting height to which will increase gradually per round once all the participating tandems have already taken their turns.
- A dog will be considered to have passed a round when the dog has successfully jumped over the Palisade within the three (3) tries.

LONG JUMP:

- There will be an agreed starting length to which will increase gradually per round once all the participating tandems have already taken their turns.
- A dog will be considered to have passed a round when the dog has successfully jumped across the Long Jump without touching it within the three (3) tries.
